MOBILITY IN OUTPATIENT ENVIRONMENT: NEW MODELS OF CARE

Australia's population growth in recent decades has been stronger among older age groups compared with younger groups: In 2013, people aged 65 and over comprised 14% of the population compared with 9% in 1973, while people aged under 25 comprised 32% of the population compared with 45% 40 years earlier.

WEARABLE TECHNOLOGY TO MONITOR HEALTH AND PERSONAL HEALTH MANAGEMENT

Keeping technology relevant and advanced - Paradigm shift from episodic, reactive healthcare to pre-emptive, preventive healthcare

Wearable patient monitoring devices that can continuously monitor a patient's blood pressure, pulse rate, respiration rate, skin temperature, blood oxygen saturation and other vital signs. Measurements are sent via WiFi to the nurse's station, allowing a greater number of patients to be closely monitored at any one time and reducing the risk of costly emergency events. Health Kiosk: People to take greater ownership of their health outcomes.

Overcoming eHealth Silos and moving towards integrated care to provide holistic and patient-centric care


